FLIPPING THE SCRIPT

- Shift pedagogy that shrouds the platform and inhibits its perception as a "tool."
- In retrospect, still user centric.

FLIPPING THE SCRIPT

- Despite anchoring on automation, efficiency, and convenience; it is nonetheless reliant upon critical thinking.
- It is a tool caught in obscurity, it is all powerful nor it is rudimentary (i.e., context is key).

- Due to prior discourse, ChatGPT and other related AI tools are alienated.
- Despite this, students find it to be a helpful aid for finding resources and composing study guides.
- In the test, a major gap was exposed, that the limits of the tool have not yet fully grasped and legitimized.
- In filling the gap, a holistic approach is needed (pedagogical, cultural, and administrative).

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
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OFF TO THE DRAWING BOARD

- In the academe, communication in relation to policy making must tap into both the structural (direct) and institutional (indirect) facets of command.
